The Synod, therefore, seeks to recruit suitably qualified, experienced, result-oriented, creative and honest persons to fill the position of Program coordinator.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY
Use Savings and Credit Associations (SCAs) to combat economic poverty through the reconciliation of relationships with God, self, others, and creation.

JOB SUMMARY
The Program Coordinator will supervise the Field Coordinators in their promotion of Savings and Credit Associations in the church. This role will include management, training, overseeing, monitoring, and evaluating the Field Coordinators and the savings groups.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITY

- I. **Management**
 - a. Provide insights in the improvement and standardization of savings members training.
 - b. Monitor and evaluate the progress toward implementing the activity plans and provide guidance in implementing corrective actions as needed.
- a. Analyze, compile and provide program, budget, logistic and technical support.

II. **Training**

- a. Train and mentor Field Coordinators.
- b. Supervise the Field Coordinator's training activities.
- c. Assess and certify Field Coordinators in collaboration with Hope International lead trainer.
- b. Conduct orientation training for church leaders.
- b. Ensure that the savings members have gone through the SCA curriculum.

III. **Reporting**

- a. Generate monthly reports according to the program templates.
- D. Participate in the monitoring and evaluation exercises.
- c. Prepare and maintain program reports (hard and soft copies) in an orderly manner.

- a. Maintain a healthy spiritual life through Biblical, personal, spiritual disciplines.
- b. Participate in prayer meeting and spiritual retreat held for program staff.
